Insurance coverage and affordability

SB243: Establishing a committee to study implementing a state-based health insurance exchange.

SB173-FN: Relative to surprise medical bills.

HB655-FN: relative to the office of professional licensure and certification.

SB237-FN: Relative to the child care scholarship program and making an appropriation therefor.

SB221: (New Title) Establishing a study committee to examine day care access and affordability.

SB241-FN: Relative to graduated public assistance programs.

HB368-FN: Relative to protections related to receiving gender-affirming health care or gender-affirming mental health care.

Housing

SB231-FN: Establishing a historic housing tax credit and making appropriations for workforce housing and affordable housing

SB224: Relative to housing opportunity zones and inclusionary zoning.

HB469-FN: Prohibiting discrimination against tenants holding certain vouchers for purposes of renting dwellings.

SB47: Establishing a commission to study barriers to increased density of residential development in New Hampshire.

SB145-FN: Relative to New Hampshire housing champion designation for municipalities and making appropriations therefor.

HB554-FN: Relative to treatment alternatives to opioids.

SB32-FN: Relative to the opioid abatement trust fund.

HB470-FN: Relative to fentanyl test strips and other drug checking equipment.

SB85-FN-A: Relative to emergency behavioral health services and behavioral health crisis programs.
