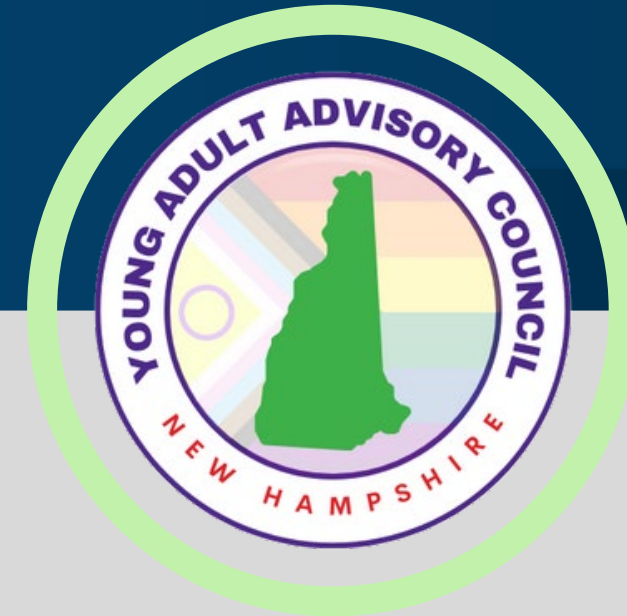
CPR/First Aid

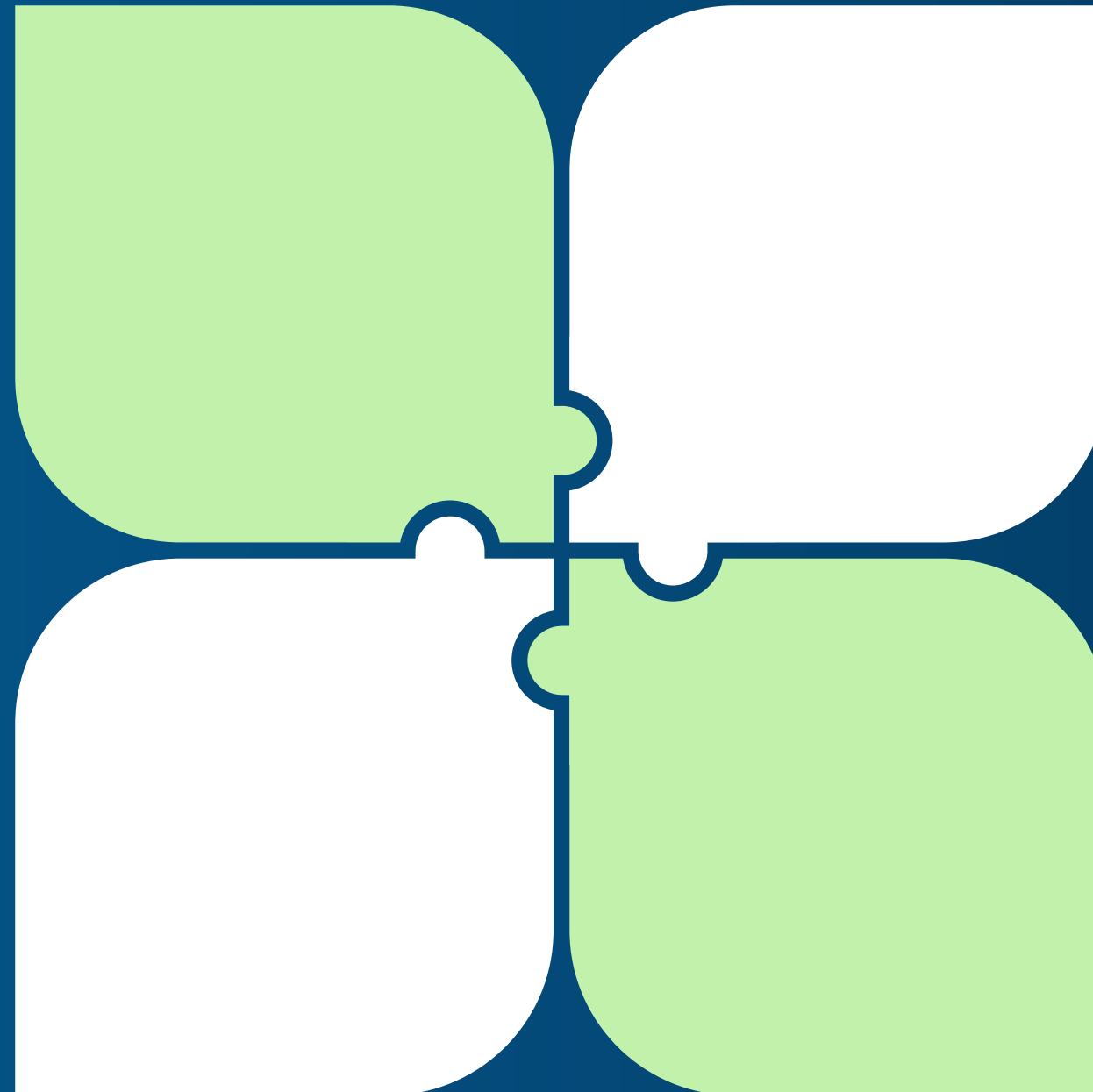
